What is new in middle school?

- Students make new friends from different schools.
- Students take eight classes with different teachers.
- Block schedule
 - Most classes meet every other day.
- Student VUE and Parent VUE (SIS)
 - Check class grades and attendance.
- Grading
 - Students earn letter grades instead of number grades.
- Flex Class
 - Advisory period that all students are assigned to.

Middle School Class Schedule



A middle school schedule contains **eight class periods**.

All students take these **five** classes:

1. English
2. Social Studies
3. Science
4. Math
5. Health & Physical Education

1. English	5. Health & PE
2. Social Studies	6. Elective 1
3. Science	7. Elective 2
4. Math	8. Flex

Students have two additional class periods for electives.

All students have a Flex class period that is automatically assigned. This is not part of the course selection process. This class period includes school-wide lessons (SEL, IB, AVID), independent work time, academic support and enrichment.

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Frequently Asked Questions



What is lunch like?

- Lunch takes place during 5th and 6th periods. A 15-minute break is attached to the lunch period.
- We have 3 lunch periods: A, B, C.
 - Your 5th and 6th period teachers will tell you what time you eat lunch on the first day of school.
- Teachers walk students to the cafeteria for the first few days of school.
- Students sit with their 5th and 6th period class for the first few weeks of school.

Will I get a locker?

- Lockers are given by request only, after the first few weeks of school.
- Many students do not use lockers, as it is helpful to have all of your items with you at all times.
